

Overview of Weekend

Friday

Registration begins on Friday afternoon at 4:30 pm. Dinner is served at 6:30, followed by a welcome/orientation and opening talk. The evening concludes with a celebration of the Eucharist.

Saturday

The morning bell begins our day at 7:00, after which we gather for prayer, then breakfast at 8:00 am. Throughout the day there are opportunities for Reconciliation, spiritual direction, and the celebration of the Eucharist, as well as time for personal prayer, rest and reflection.

Conferences focusing on this year's theme, **“Called By Name: Living Faithfully in Deed and in Truth,”** are offered by the ministry team throughout the day. The day concludes with dinner and common prayer.

Sunday

Once again rising at 7:00 am, we then share prayer, breakfast, and a “closing conversation.” Guests are invited to depart following the morning's celebration of the Eucharist, which concludes around noon.

Time:

Arrive anytime after 4:30pm on Friday. A buffet supper opens the retreat at 6:30pm. Orientation and the first retreat experiences follow at 7:30 pm.

Place:

The Center (23333 Schoolcraft in Northwest Detroit) is located on 20 secure, secluded acres, easily accessible by major freeways. The spacious facility has 85 rooms with private baths, a library, chapel and gift shop.

Staff:

The Center is sponsored by the Passionist Community. Retreats are conducted by Passionist priests Fr. Pat Brennan and Fr. Phil Paxton and Mrs. Faith Offman.

Dress and Special Needs:

Casual dress and comfortable shoes are recommended. All bed linens and towels are provided; bring your own hair dryer if needed. Please inform us in advance if you have any special needs (dietary, handicap accessible room, late arrival, etc.)
